**EASY on the EYES** Our eyes tell the story sometimes even before our mouths do. That might be why they're the first to feel the process of aging. Recurring milia, sun damage and crow's feet cannot be stopped forever, but two new treatments—the **REM refresh** technologies (from \$4,000) by Drs. Kristina and Gary Goldenberg and **Trifecta Lift** (from \$6,000) by Dr. Robert Schwarcz—can significantly delay them. The four-step REM refresh process begins with Ulthera to help stimulate collagen production and tightens the skin, thereby decreasing the appearance of undereye bags. Next, fillers lift up the depression between the eyelid and the cheek that collects light and casts an unflattering shadow onto the undereye. After fillers, doctors inject Botox for smoothing out the crow's feet and finish by treating the skin with chemical peels or laser. During the Trifecta Lift, Dr. Schwarcz makes an incision inside the eyelid and removes some of the fat. He utilizes a CO2 laser instead of cutting the skin, which improves texture, and follows up with PRP protein plasma to give the skin vibrancy and improve healing time. The cost of REM refresh is broken out over time, as different clients might wish to undergo less treatments lasting a shorter period of time than others.
